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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Reserving Your Event Date

Your event date will be reserved when we receive a signed copy of this Agreement; until a signed copy is received your event will be pending for only 2 weeks. You are responsible for keeping us updated on the guaranteed guest count. Quail Crossing is not responsible for shortage of anything if we are not made aware that you reached enough guests for a "private event."

Food and Beverage / Course Arrangements

Our Food and Beverage department will provide you with services for your event. All menu items, course arrangements, and other details pertaining to this event must be received 30 days prior to the event, or if booked less than 30 days prior to the event, within 72 hours of booking. Menu selections must be confirmed with our Food and Beverage Department. We reserve the right to change the location of meals, beverage set ups and award ceremonies depending upon the guaranteed guest count. All food and beverage prices are subject to 18.75% service charge and state tax if applicable. *All food and alcoholic beverages consumed on site must be purchased from us.* We do not permit the service of alcoholic beverages to anyone who is under the age of 21, or who we determine is intoxicated. Only our employees may prepare and serve food and beverages, including alcohol.

Golf Participants (If Applicable)

The final number of guests that will participate in the Golf Outing (the guaranteed guest count) is due 10 days prior to the golf outing date. Copies of the pairing sheet are due 3 days prior to your event. We will try to accommodate up to a 10% increase above the guaranteed guest count on the golf outing date. We reserve the right to change the format of your tournament if you change the guaranteed guest count. We require a minimum of 60 participants to shut down the course for a private golf event. If 60 participants are not met we may remain open for pass-holders/public play. We will make sure that other play does not interfere with the participants in your outing. Quail owned golf carts must be operated by an individual with a valid driver's license.

Guarantee /Final Payment

You are obligated for and guarantee payment of all charges. All outstanding balances must be settled by the event date. Payments of final charges are due on the day of the event or have to have a date set to make payment within the next 7 days of your event. Fees may also include service charges, breakage, other services or merchandise purchased on the event date, cash bar, and applicable taxes. If final payment is not made after the 7 days given from the date of event you will be charged an additional fee every week payment is late.

Proper Conduct/Indemnity

You are responsible for the proper conduct and attire of all participants, use and care of the golf course, clubhouse facilities, equipment and golf carts. You are also responsible for any injuries to people, or damage to property, equipment, and golf carts caused by the participants of your event. You agree to promptly pay for all injuries to people and damage to property upon presentation of the charges. You agree to indemnify, defend and hold us harmless from all damages and injuries caused by participants of your event, except to the extent caused by the negligence or willful misconduct of our employees or agents. We reserve the right to remove anyone from our property who engages in disruptive, violent, profane, intoxicated, or abusive behavior. You may ask the Event Coordinator about insurance programs for your event that are offered by independent service providers.

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Inclement Weather (If Applicable)

Frost, fog, rain, or other inclement weather may cause a delay to the start of your event. If playing conditions require cancellation of the event by us, the event will be rescheduled at the first available date that is mutually convenient. The outing party shall not be entitled to a refund for any weather-related cancellation of the outing, whether partially or totally (In the event that less than all 18 holes were completed on the day of outing).

Force Majeure

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this agreement, we shall be excused from our obligations under this agreement to the extent and whenever we shall be prevented from the performance of such obligations by any Force Majeure Event. In the preceding sentence, "Force Majeure Event" means any one or more of the following events or circumstances that, alone or in combination, directly or indirectly, adversely affects in any material respect our operation of the golf course facility: fire, earthquake, storm or other casualty; strikes, lockouts, or other labor interruptions; war, rebellion, riots, acts of terrorism, or other civil unrest; epidemics, quarantine or any other public health restrictions or public health advisories. In the event of a Force Majeure Event, you will have the option of re-scheduling your event on the first available date that is mutually convenient.

Cancellations

If you cancel your event with less than 10 days prior notice you agree to pay a cancellation fee of \$500 under this agreement. Cancellation fees are due by the event date.

General Rules and Conditions

Please communicate the following rules and conditions to your participants:

- 1. Only two riders and two bags per golf cart. All participants must observe the safety rules printed in the cart, and must drive prudently as course conditions allow.
- 2. Each participant must have a set of clubs unless sharing with a partner.
- 3. Participants are asked to keep up with the group in front of them.
- 4. Golf participants are required to adhere to the Dress Code. Please ask the Event Coordinator for a copy. We are a "Soft Spike" Company.

The terms "you", "your" and "yours" refer to: (1) your corporation, limited liability company or non-profit organization if this agreement is executed by a representative of such organizations, or (2) the individual chairperson of the event executing this Agreement on behalf of a group of individuals, social club or other unincorporated organization. The terms "we", "us" and "our" refer to Quail Crossing Golf Course. If you are signing this Agreement on behalf of a corporation, limited liability company or non-profit organization you represent and warrant that you have the authority to execute and deliver this Agreement, and that this Agreement constitutes the legally valid and binding obligation of your company or organization. -If you do food through us you will get a discounted golf rate at \$30 per person (rate only includes Cart and Greens fees not food)

Shotgun start time & set up based on teams

- -Outings booked on a Friday, Saturday, or Sunday have to have a shotgun start by 7:00 am/ 8:00 am or a shotgun start at 12:00 pm / 1:00 pm.
- -Any outings booked fewer than 48 people (max of 12 Teams) will just be made as regular tee times or a small gap on our tee sheet will be blocked off and we will still be open for play to the public (Public will not interfere with play of outing party unless the pace of play is slow).

-You must have a minimum of 60 people (15 Teams) for your outing to be a "Private Outing."

*Private Outing meaning our course will be closed for play but our practice green and range will still be open to the public.

^{*}All members & non-members pay the set outing rate. There is no discount for members or members with a trail or cart pass.

Food Menu

*All items will be made at the club and an 18% Gratuity charge will be added for any food provided by Quail Crossing.

Meal examples:

-Hamburgers/ Cheeseburgers: served with 2 sides of choice

- Hot dogs/ Brats: Served with 2 sides of choice

-BBQ sliders: served with 2 sides of choice

-Build your own Deli Bar: Includes Ham and Turkey as Deli meats, variety of cheeses, and all the basic toppings to go on them. Included with 2 sides of your choice.

-Taco Bar (Beef or Chicken): Includes hard and soft shells, Tortilla chips, salsa, lettuce, shredded cheese, tomatoes, sour cream, etc.

-Soup: served with grilled cheese

-Spaghetti: served with toast

- Pricing on food will be decided based on what items you decide on and how many people we are cooking for.
 <u>If</u>
 <u>you already have a certain meal in mind you do not have to pick one of these options.</u> Our pricing would include the set up and tear down, plates, cups, cutlery, etc.
- Beverage packages vary and can vary from a ticket based system (ex: 2 tickets per guest) or in bulk purchase.
 - -Fountain package: \$2.00 per person all day (isn't included for mixed drinks)
- You are allowed to provide your own food vendors with an additional fee of \$\frac{\$100}{100}\$ this all will still depend on what Covid- 19 restrictions are in place and how you will be serving it.
